

How to Use the Oyako(Parent- Child)Salon

○Note

We want both parents and children to be safe while at the Center. Parents are responsible for their own children's safety. Please follow these rules, so that everyone can enjoy themselves.

The Oyako Salon offers you the opportunity to play with children, as well as to communicate with other parents. Please watch your children carefully at all times.

◆Entrance You can enter at the gate on the western side of the building.

◆Parking and Bicycles

A parking place for bicycles is located on the western side of the building. We have no auto parking lot, but you may use a toll parking lot of Tsuda-nishi Public Corporation on the southern side of Nishinomiya Police Station for your car.

◆Place for Baby buggies

Please leave your baby buggy on the left side (northern side) of the gate. Please fold your buggy and line up from the edge one by one.

◆Footwear

Children should play without shoes. Parents may walk barefoot, but if you would like to put on indoor shoes, we ask you to use the Center's slippers, or bring your own indoor shoes with soft soles only. There are shoe boxes provided for your outdoor shoes.

◆Reception

Please fill out a form at reception desk, and attach a name card to your child.

◆Toys & Books

You may freely play with toys and books of the Salon. After use, please replace them where they are stored. Please inform the staff if the toys and books are damaged.

You may not bring your own toys or books.

The Oyako Salon offers you the opportunity to play with children, as well as to communicate with other parents. Please watch your children carefully at all times.

◆Information Corner

Brochures are available free of charge. However, we ask you not to take out the materials from our information files.

◆Food & Drink

No food or drink, except tea, is allowed in the Center. Please use the Suckling Room to breast-feed. (Please bring hot water for milk.)

◆Valuables

Any valuables are your responsibility, so please take care of them.
(The Center assumes no responsibility for loss within the pavilion.)
A locker for your baggage is available at the reception desk.

◆Belongings

Please write the child's name on your property such as towels and socks.
If you leave something behind, we will keep it for about two weeks.

◆Garbage Disposal and Diapers

We ask you to please bring any garbage and used diapers back homewith you.

◆Other

- Before you leave, please do not forget to return the name card back to the reception desk.
- Smoking is not permitted anywhere in the Center.
- Please refrain from all video, and keep photo taking to a minimum.
