Vaccinations

There are vaccinations for Rotavirus, Hepatitis B, Hib, Pediatric Pneumococcal, DPT-IVP(Diphtheria, Pertussis, [Whooping Cough], Tetanus, IPV), DT(Diphtheria, Tetanus) vaccinations, IPV, BCG, a measles rubella combination, measles, rubella, varicella, Japanese encephalitis, cervical cancer prevention, Adult Pneumococcal, inoculations against influenza for the elderly, and COVID-19 vaccine. Vaccinations are given to individuals at assigned medical facilities. If you wish to get vaccinations outside Nishinomiya City, some procedures should be taken before the vaccination. Please contact the following division 10 days prior to the date of the vaccination.

Regarding vaccinations for infants and small children, see section 11-4 Health Services for babies / Vaccinations.

Regarding the information about vaccinations, notice is given in the City Newsletter (Shisei News) (every month on the 25th, but only in December on the 10th).
