1. Vaccination sites

① **Individual vaccination:**

Medical institutions within Nishinomiya City (approximately 200 institutions)

② **Group vaccination:**

5 public facilities; Central Municipal Hospital, Yamaguchi Hall, Shiose Community Center, Chuo Health & Welfare Center, Kitaguchi Health & Welfare Center

2. How to make an appointment & the start date of making appointments

When making an appointment, you will need the coupon number written on your vaccination coupon mailed to you beforehand.

① **Individual vaccinations; starting from May 12, 9:00 am**

3. At the time of vaccination

① What to bring

- ◆ [Vaccination coupon](#) (a set of 2 coupons are in one sheet. Bring the whole sheet as it is.)
- ◆ [Prevaccination Screening Questionnaire for COVID-19 vaccine](#) (It was mailed with the vaccination coupon. Please fill out the necessary information before coming to the vaccination site.)

- ◆ ID document (driver's license, health insurance certificate, residence card, etc.)

② Precautions for COVID-19 vaccination

- ◆ If you have fever or do not feel well, please refrain from taking the vaccination and contact the call center or medical institution where you made the appointment.
- ◆ The second dose should be administered three weeks after your first dose.
- ◆ After your vaccination, it is necessary to stay at the vaccination site for more than 15 minutes.
**People who suffered from severe allergic symptoms including anaphylactic shock in the past need to stay more than 30 minutes.
- ◆ The vaccine will be administered near your shoulders. Please wear clothing that allows to easily expose your shoulders.

【Symptoms of side effects】

- Pain and swelling of the vaccinated area · Headache
 - Pain in the joints and muscles · Tiredness, chills and fever
- ※ Vaccination is not mandatory. Please make sure to gain a full understanding of the risks of the vaccine and make your own decision to be vaccinated or not.
- ※ It is confirmed to have side effects after the second dose more than the first.
