If involved in a traffic accident

If you are a victim

- (1) Report the accident to the police immediately. If the accident is not reported to the police, the Kotsu Jiko Shomei-sho (Traffic Accident Certificate), required to receive insurance payments due to a traffic accident, may not be obtainable.
- (2) Confirm the address and name of the driver and also the vehicle registration number, date of insurance entry and name of insurance company.
- (3) Even if you think your injury is minor, have a medical check-up.

If you caused an accident

- (1) Help the victim (give first-aid, call an ambulance).
- (2) Notify the nearest police station.
- (3) Notify your insurance company.
