Handling of Certificate of Alien Registration (those filed and issued by July 8, 2012)

What is the Certificate of Alien Registration?

The Certificate of Alien Registration is a card that was made based on the alien registration system and abolished on July 9, 2012. It can be continuously used for a certain period of time after July 9, 2012.

Expiration date of Certificate of Alien Registration

The Certificate of Alien Registration you currently have can be used until the date of your 16th birthday. Apply for the issuance of a new card (Special Permanent Resident Certificate) by that date. If you are over 16th years old, your term has expired already so please apply for the new card (Special Permanent Resident Certificate) immediately.

Required documents

You need to prepare the following three documents to change your Certificate of Alien Registration to a new card.

- (i) Certificate of Alien Registration
- (ii) Passport
- (iii) 1 photograph (4 cm X 3 cm, taken within the past three months)

Application by proxy

Basically, you need to file an application personally. However, you can also appoint a family member aged 16 and over who belongs to the same household to apply as proxy. In that case, identification (e.g. driver's license, passport) of the proxy is also required.

- If you cannot file an application in any cases other than above, contact the Main Office of the Nishinomiya City Hall or your nearest branch.
- None of the above procedures can be performed at ACTA Nishinomiya Civic Service Station or Civic Service Center.
