

Universities and Colleges

Universities and colleges are schools for students who have graduated from senior high school.

You must sit an entrance examination in order to enter a university.

If a person has not graduated from a Japanese junior high school or senior high school, that person is still eligible to sit an entrance examination if he/she has obtained an education the equivalent of a Japanese senior high school.

Some universities and colleges have special systems for foreign residents.
