1. When you are diagnosed with COVID-19



♦ If you have a risk of developing serious symptoms (if you are over 65 years of age, may need to be admitted to a hospital, or pregnant, etc.), the Health Center will send a text message (short message) to your cellphone and call.

If your condition deteriorates, call the Medical Consultation Center for COVID-19.

- ◆ If you are under 65 years of age, do not have underlying medical conditions, not obese (BMI of 30 or higher), or not pregnant, the Health Center will <u>not</u> contact you.

≪The period to recuperate at home ≫

If you don't have any symptoms 7 days from the day after the specimen collection date

X If you develop any symptoms during your recuperation period at home, then 7 days from the next day you develop symptoms and until 24 hours after your symptoms subside.

If you are symptomatic 7 days from next the day of the illness onset date and also 24 hours after your symptoms subside

***What is the illness onset date?**

The day you start to have cold symptoms such as fever over 37.5 °C, cough, sputum, nasal congestion, sore throat, headache, fatigue, diarrhea, or the date you started to have loss of taste or smell.

When you think you are a close contact with a patient The Health Center will not contact you.
If someone you know or someone in your family





- becomes infected with COVID-19, please confirm the test date, the illness onset date of the infected person, and also the last date you met with the patient. Then determine by yourself whether you are a "close contact" or not.
 - **X** A <u>close contact</u> is someone who met with the infected person during his/her "infectious period" and falls under either of the following conditions.
 - Someone who lives with the infected person
 - ② Someone who had contact with the infected person for a long time (including inside of a car or aircraft)
 - ③ Someone who had a conversation for more than 15 minutes within arm's reach of an infected person who wore no mask.
 - 4 Someone who wore no mask and had a conversation with an infected person for more than 15 minutes within the distance of 1 m.

XWhat is an "infectious period"?

- · Symptomatic patient : it is from 2 days before one starts developing symptoms.
- · Patient without symptoms: it is from 2 days before the specimen collection date.

≪Note to the close contact≫

If you don't have any symptoms

Please stay home for 5 days from the next day of the
last date you met with the infected person.

<u>XIt is allowed for patients who fulfill certain conditions to go out for a minimum period of time to perform necessary duties such as grocery shopping.</u>

Eligible person: anyone who is passed 24 hours after the symptoms subsided or who is asymptomatic

Necessary condition: to take a thorough preventive measures against infection when going out

It should be for short hours, you should wear a mask and not to use public transportation, etc.
