1 Until May 7

- ◆ Eligible person: Anyone 12 years or older who finished the primary series of vaccination (1st and 2nd doses) and passed 3 months or more from the date of the prior dose of vaccination
- **♦** Type of vaccine: Vaccine manufactured by Pfizer (Omicron adapted bivalent vaccine)
- ♦ Number of doses: One dose

2 From May 8 – Aug

- ◆Eligible person: Elderly people (65 or over), people with underlying conditions, healthcare workers,

 employees of elderly facilities, etc. who finished their primary series of vaccination (1st and 2nd doses) and passed 3 months or more from the date of the prior dose of vaccination
- **◆** Type of vaccine: Vaccine manufactured by Pfizer (Omicron adapted bivalent vaccine)
- ◆Number of doses: One dose

3 From Sep and after

- **◆Eligible person**: Anyone over 5 years of age who finished the primary series of vaccination (1st and 2nd doses) and passed 3 months or more from the date of the prior dose of vaccination.
- **♦**Type of vaccine: The vaccine to be used is not yet decided
- **♦**Number of doses: One dose

[Information about the COVID-19 vaccination for children ages 5 - 11]

- **◆Eligible person**: Children between ages from 5 to 11 at the time of vaccination
- **X** It is necessary for a parent to give consent to the vaccination and accompany the child at the time of vaccination. Vaccination is not mandatory.
- **◆**Type of vaccine and number of doses:

For primary series of vaccinations (first and second dose):

Generally 2 times, with a 3 week interval in between doses

Pfizer pediatric vaccine (It is a different vaccine from the vaccine used for people 12 years and older).

For additional dose(third dose):Eligible person→anyone between ages 5 and 11 who is 3 months passed the date of the second dose of vaccination

Pfizer pediatric vaccine (Omicron adapted bivalent vaccine)

◆Vaccination coupon: For primary series (1st and 2nd doses) of vaccinations, the coupons were sent out to eligible children.

For additional dose (3rd dose), the coupons will be sent out to eligible children, one month prior to the month that is 3 months passed the date of the second dose of vaccination.

- ◆Vaccination site: The vaccination will be administered at individual medical institutions (pediatrics) within

 Nishinomiya City.
- ♦ How to make a vaccination appointment: For vaccinations on and after Apr 1, direct appointment at medical institutions.

[Information about the COVID-19 vaccination for babies and infants from 6 months to 4 years old]

- ◆ Term of vaccination : Until Mar 31, 2024
- **♦**Eligible person: Babies and infants from 6 months to 4 years old
- ** It is necessary for a parent to give consent to the vaccination and accompany the child at the time of vaccination. Vaccination is not mandatory.
- **◆**Type of vaccine: Pfizer vaccine (for 6 months old to 4 years old)

** Information leaflet for the vaccine from 6 months old to 4 years old (Japanese)

◆Number and interval between doses: 3 times for the initial vaccinations

1st dose of vaccination ⇒ 3 weeks ⇒ 2^{nd} dose of vaccination ⇒ 8 weeks ⇒ 3^{rd} dose of vaccination

- ◆Vaccination coupon: The coupons will be sent out to eligible children in sequence.
- **♦**Vaccination appointment: Please make an appointment directly to the medical institution.
